Job Description:

(YTCA), the North American corporate research and development center of Yazaki Corporation is conducting a search for a full-time Environmental Health and Safety (EHS) Technician to add to the team. The qualified candidate will be responsible for assisting the safety and hazardous waste management of all activities at YTCA and supporting Facilities in maintaining daily operational functions. The duties include:

- Maintain safety equipment and supplies, including: eyewash stations, showers, fire extinguishers, emergency response items, etc.
- Inspect hazardous waste storage areas weekly in compliance with Federal, State, and local regulations, and coordinate pickup and disposal of all hazardous wastes, as needed.
- Perform daily safety building walk-throughs, and document satisfactory and/or unsatisfactory safety behavior, and assist in the implementation of YTCA's Safety Incentive Program.
- Coordinate YTCA's industrial hygiene/medical monitoring program (e.g., radiation dosimetry, PFT's, fume hood testing, audiometric monitoring, chemical emissions monitoring, etc.).
- Carry out duties, as directed by the supervisor, to ensure YTCA complies with various regulatory agencies (e.g., Prop 65 list and warnings, quarterly APCD emission summary, hazardous waste database maintenance and summary, HazMat Business Plan updates, HazWaste questionnaire, etc.).
- Keep management informed of any deviations to procedure/policy.
- Performs additional EHS and/or Facilities duties and tasks as needed.

Requirements:

- Minimum high school diploma or GED required, and some college preferred.
- Requires two (2) plus years in HazMat handling operations and knowledge of current applicable regulations.
- Current 40-hour HazWOPER certification (or willingness and ability to complete upon hire).
- College-level chemistry is a plus.
- College certificate in Environmental Technology, HazMat Management, or college-level chemistry is a plus.
- OHST, CHMM, and/or current First Aid/CPR certification is a plus
- Excellent talent to interact with people in a positive and courteous manner.
- Ability to work in a team environment.
- Strong written and verbal communication skills.
- Basic knowledge of Microsoft Office Applications, specifically, Outlook, Word, and Excel.
